Temporary Assistance

Temporary Assistance: Temporary Assistance recipients totaled 615,099 in July 2003, increasing by 5,084 (+0.8%) from the previous month. Related expenditures totaled \$147,842,945 in July 2003 increasing approximately \$.8 million (+0.6%) over June 2003.

Food Stamps

Food Stamps: Recipients of Food Stamps numbered 1,464,395 in July 2003, increasing by 10,257 (+0.7%) over June 2003. Food Stamps expenditures totaled \$144,377,424 in July 2003, increasing by \$2.7 million (+1.9%) over the previous month.

Supplemental Security Income

Supplemental Security Income: For July 2003, SSI recipients (including Mental Hygiene) totaled 623,065 decreasing 5,330 (-0.8%) from the previous month . SSI expenditures in July totaled \$289,407,292 decreasing approximately \$6.9 million (-2.3%) from June 2003.

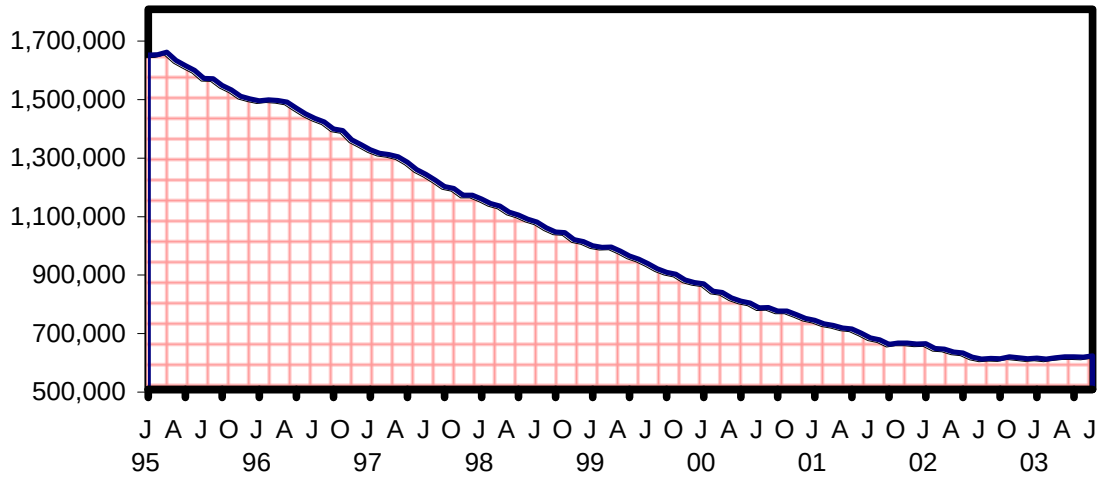
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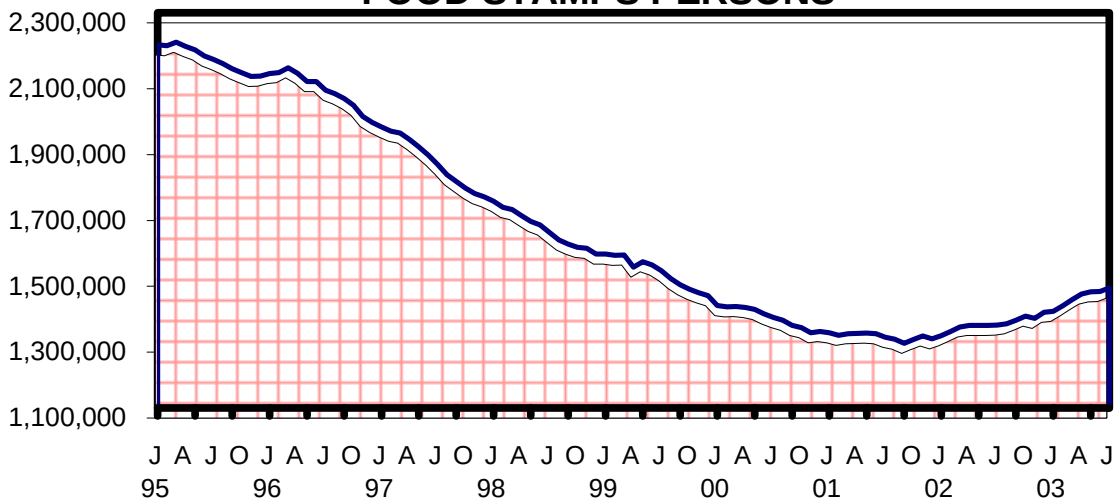
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NEW YORK STATE JANUARY 1995 - JULY 2003

TEMPORARY ASSISTANCE RECIPIENTS

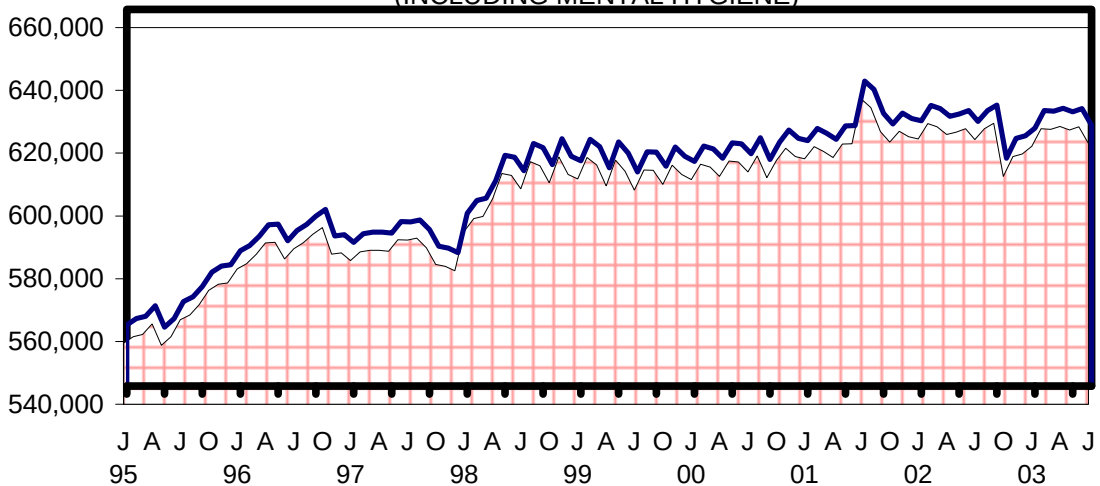


FOOD STAMPS PERSONS
