Temporary and Disability Assistance Statistics MAY 2004

Temporary Assistance

Temporary Assistance: Temporary Assistance recipients totaled 637,178 in May 2004, increasing by 3,484 (+0.5%) from the previous month. Related expenditures totaled \$160,461,009 in May 2004 increasing approximately \$1.8 million (+1.2%) over April 2004.

Food Stamps

Food Stamps: Recipients of Food Stamps numbered 1,616,306 in May 2004, increasing by 3,089 (+0.2%) over April 2004. Food Stamps expenditures totaled \$159,217,558 in May 2004, increasing over \$913,000 (+0.6%) over the previous month.

Supplemental Security Income

Supplemental Security Income: For May 2004, SSI recipients (including Mental Hygiene) totaled 629,375 increasing 797 (+0.1%) from the previous month. SSI expenditures in May totaled \$303,742,732 increasing over \$471,000 (+0.2%) from April 2004.

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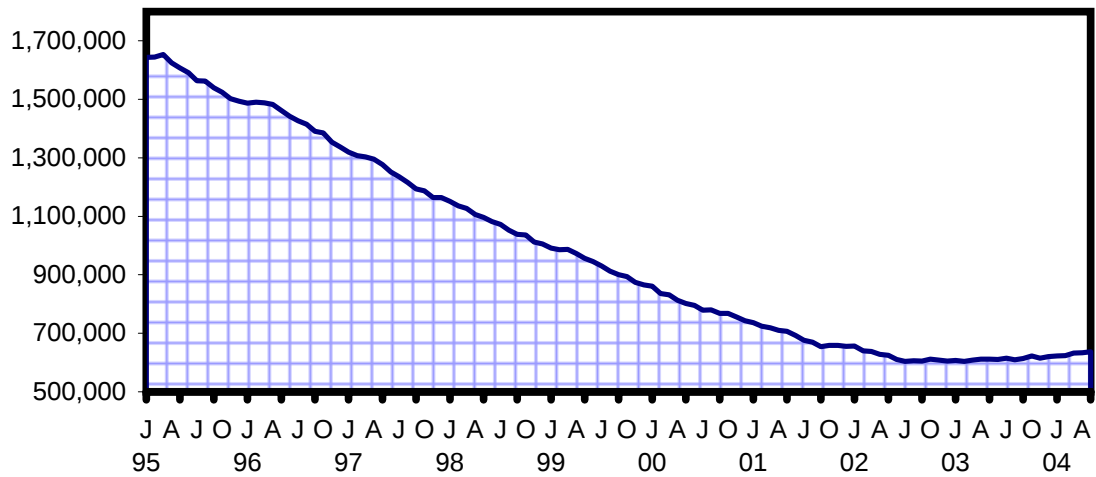
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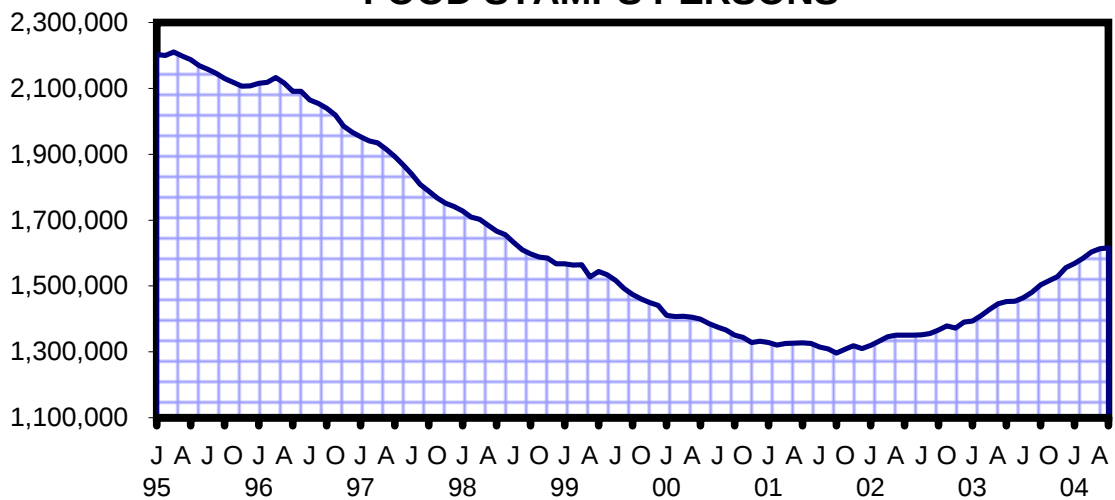

TEMPORARY ASSISTANCE RECIPIENTS

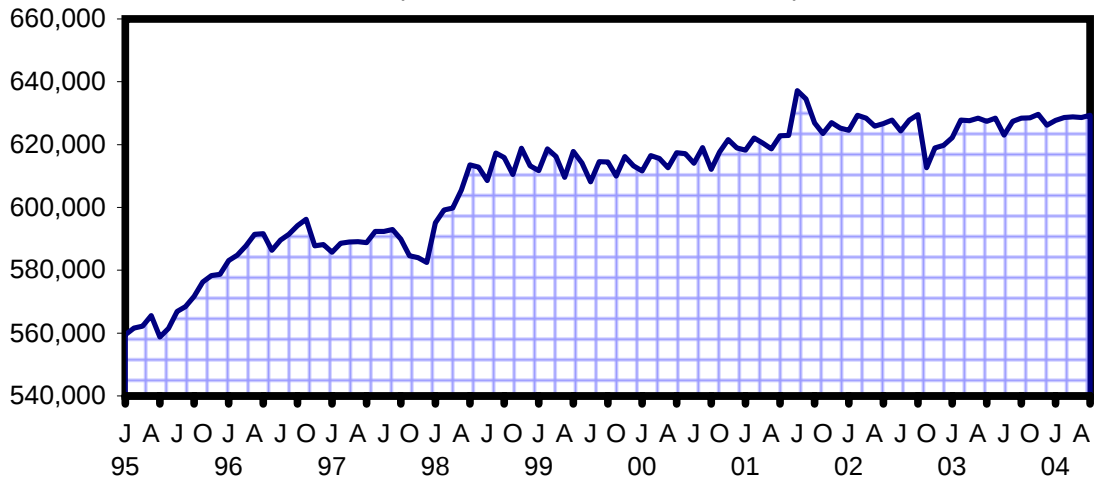


FOOD STAMPS PERSONS
