Temporary and Disability Assistance Statistics MARCH 2010

Temporary Assistance

Temporary Assistance: Temporary Assistance recipients totaled 549,344 in March 2010, increasing by 4,281 (+0.8%) from the previous month. Related expenditures totaled \$177,762,723 in March 2010, increasing by approximately \$9.9 million (+5.9%) over February 2010.

Food Stamps

Food Stamps: Recipients of Food Stamps numbered 2,754,632 in March 2010, increasing by 42,195 (+1.6%) over February 2010. Food Stamps expenditures totaled \$419,305,078 in March 2010, increasing by \$6.7million (+1.6%) over the previous month.

Supplemental Security Income

Supplemental Security Income: For March 2010, SSI recipients (including Mental Hygiene) totaled 665,760 decreasing by 10,051 (-1.5 %) from the previous month. SSI expenditures in March 2010 totaled \$375,533,891 decreasing by approximately \$10.6 million (-2.74%) from February 2010.

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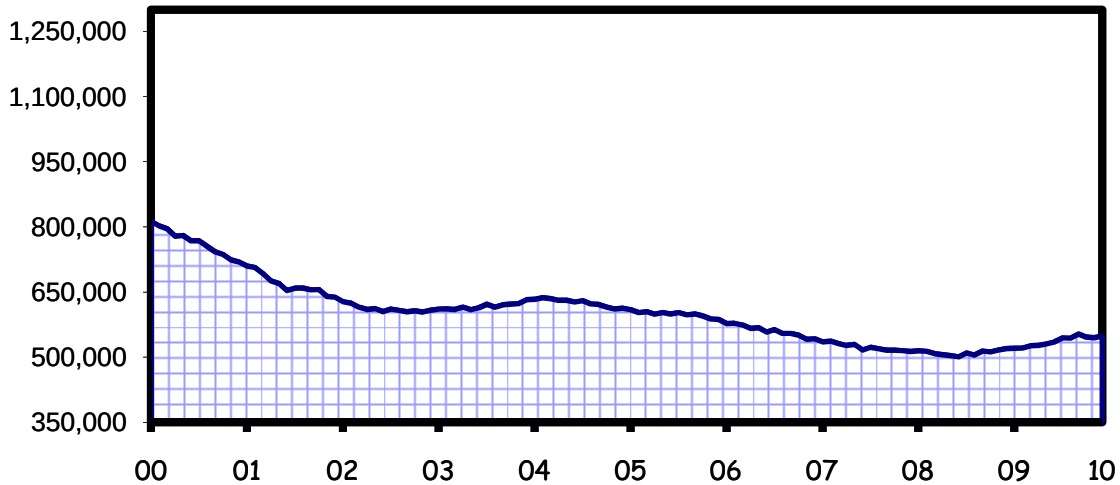
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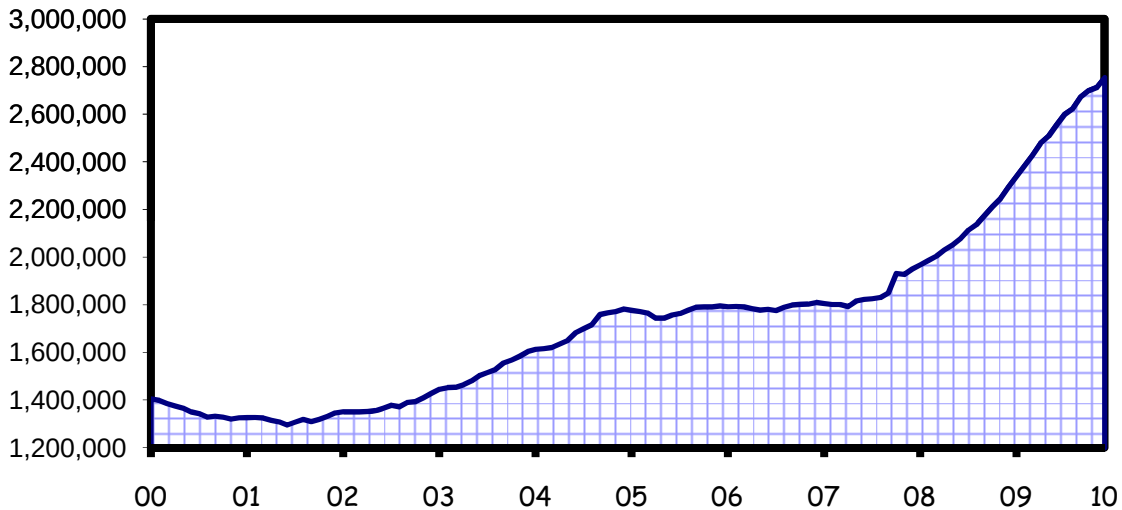
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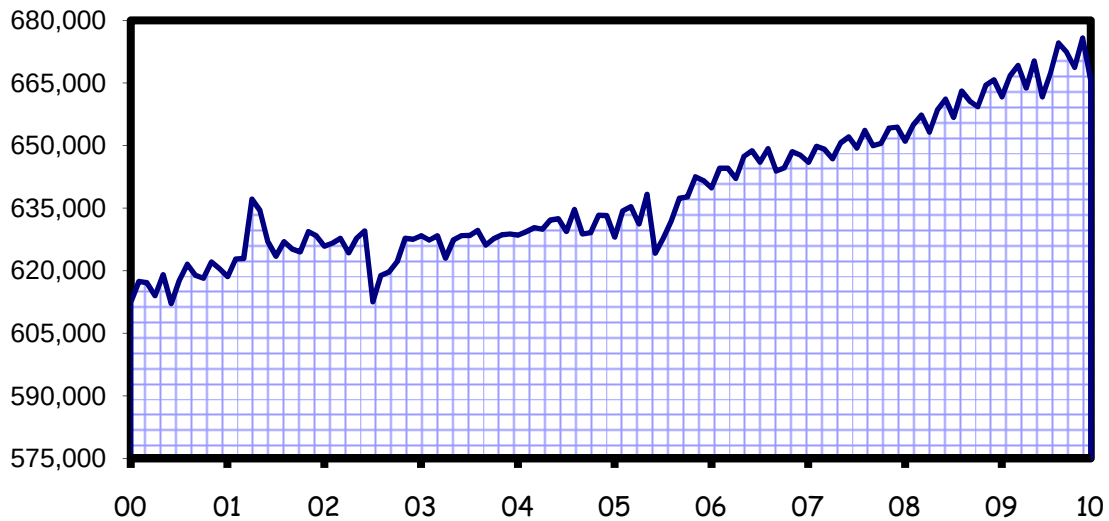
